MISSISSIPPI RIVER DEEP DRAFT CROSSINGS

Beginning on approximately 17 June 2024 and continuing until approximately 31 October 2024, the U.S. Government Dustpan Dredge HURLEY will be working at the Mississippi River Deep Draft Crossings between Baton Rouge and New Orleans, Louisiana.

The first dredging location will be at Red Eye Crossing, at approximate mile 224 Above Head of Passes (AHP) of the Mississippi River.

The dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and will give way to vessels using the waterway. Dredge personnel can be contacted on either VHF channel 16 or 67 for sailing instructions.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
