## CALCASIEU RIVER SHIP CHANNEL FORESHORE STONE PLACEMENT MILE 26 RDB & MILE 30 RDB

Commencing on or about 13 December 2024 and continuing through approximately 5 May 2025, a U.S. Government Contractor will be placing foreshore stone along the Right Descending Bank (RDB) of the Calcasieu River Ship Channel at approximate Mile 26 and Mile 30.

The Contractor will work 7 days a week, 10 hours a day, during daylight hours, and the plant will include an anchor barge with hydraulic backhoe. An office barge and various material barges will be on-site, staged along the river at these locations.

During nighttime hours, the Contractor will be staged along the Right Descending Bank (RDB) out of the Calcasieu River Channel. The M/V JAMES CHRISTOPHER and M/V EDDIE R can be contacted on VHF Marine Channels 13, 16 and 72.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
