NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 25-55

CALCASIEU RIVER
MILE 17.0 TO MILE 9.0 (UPDATE)

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 25-12, dated 12 February 2025, stating that beginning on or about 13 February 2025 and continuing until approximately 18 May 2025, the U.S. Government Contract Cutterhead Dredge NIMITZ will be working in the Calcasieu River between approximate Mile 17.0 and approximate Mile 9.0.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE LOWER LIMIT OF DREDGING HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO MILE 5 OF THE CALCASIEU RIVER, AND THE U.S. GOVERNMENT CONTRACT CUTTERHEAD DREDGE NIMITZ WILL CONTINUE WORKING UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 18 JUNE 2025.

The Dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and will give way to passing navigation. The Dredge can be contacted on either VHF Marine Channel 13 or 16 for sailing instructions.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
