GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY
LELAND BOWMAN LOCK (UPDATE)

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 25-51, dated 19 May 2025, stating that Leland Bowman Lock will have intermittent closures to navigation (up to 5 hours) from 2 June 2025 through 6 June 2025, during daylight hours, for a U.S. Government Maintenance Unit to continue installing new Hydraulic Power Units, and also closed to navigation Mondays through Fridays, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day, from 9 June 2025 through 18 July 2025, for repairs to the guidewalls.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE INSTALLATION OF NEW HYDRAULIC POWER UNITS BY A U.S. GOVERNMENT MAINTENANCE UNIT WILL BE PERFORMED FROM 16 JUNE 2025 THROUGH 20 JUNE 2025, WITH INTERMITTENT CLOSURES TO NAVIGATION (UP TO 5 HOURS) DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS.

MARINERS ARE ALSO ADVISED THAT A REVISED DAILY DAYTIME CLOSURE SCHEDULE FOR THE GUIDEWALL REPAIRS IS AS FOLLOWS:

- 23 JUNE 2025 THROUGH 2 JULY 2025 (7:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.)
- 7 JULY 2025 THROUGH 17 JULY 2025 (7:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.)
- 21 JULY 2025 THROUGH 31 JULY 2025 (7:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.)
