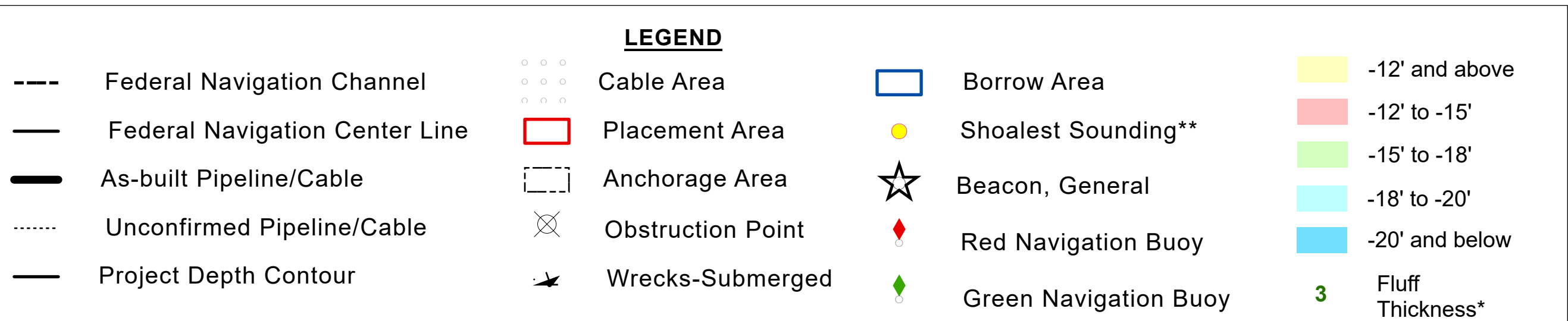
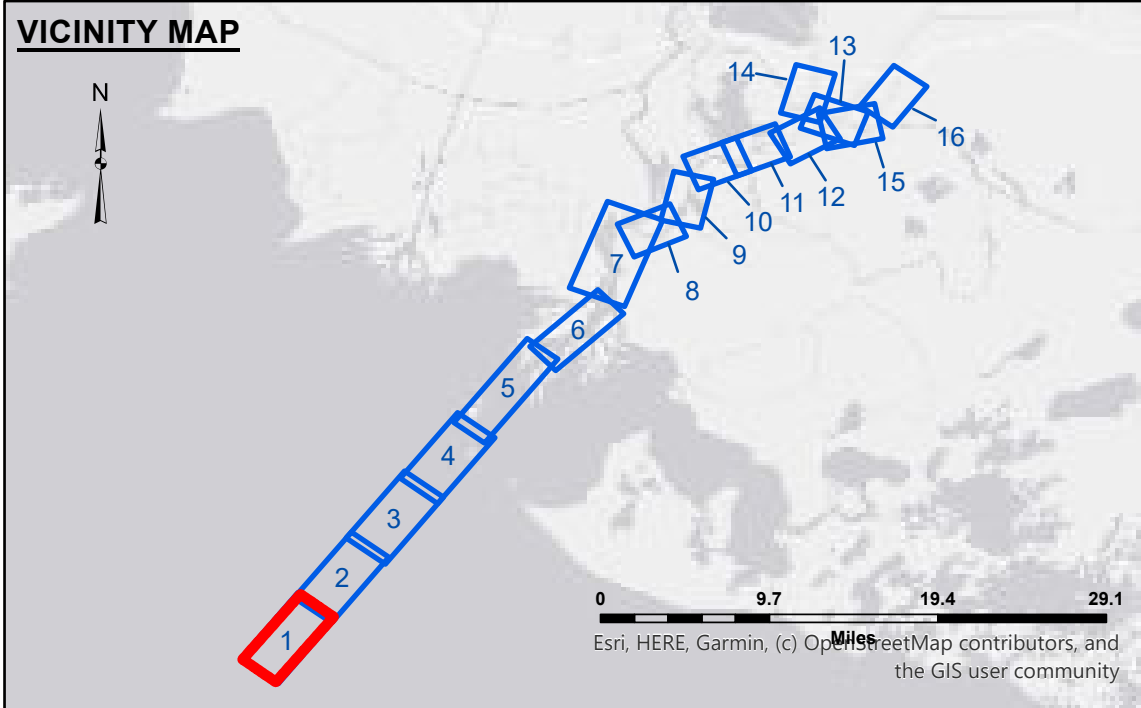
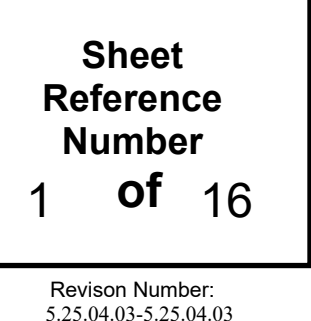
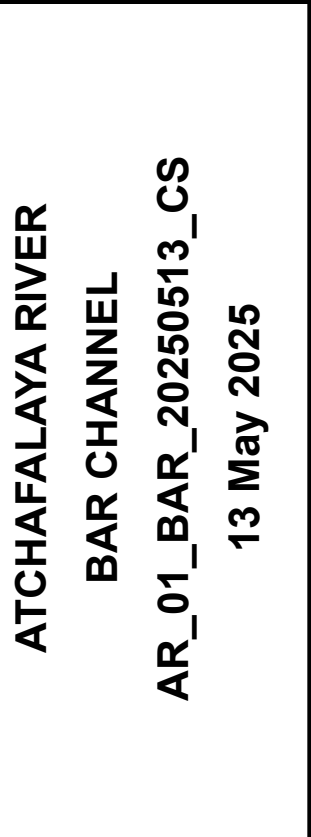
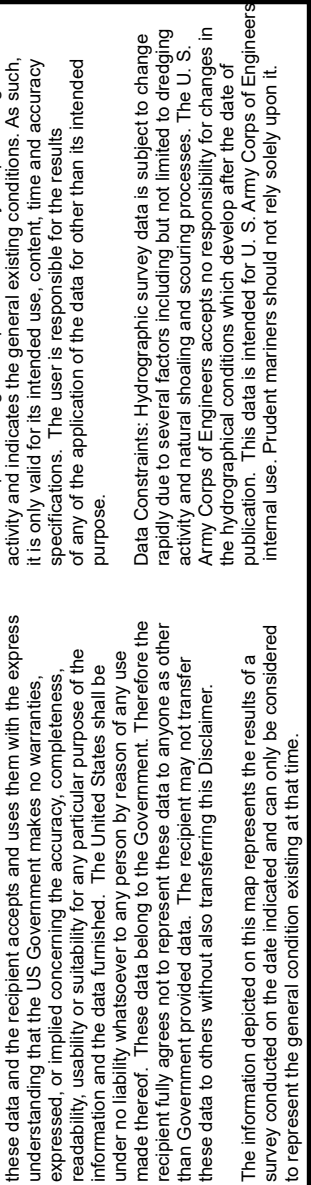


NOTES:
