Horizontal Coordinate System:
Reference Epoch Date of 1982 (NAD83), known as the State Plane Coordinate System (SPCS), Louisiana South Zone. Distance units in U.S. Survey Feet.

Vertical Datum:
Soundings are shown in feet and indicate depths below Mean Low Gulf Datum (MLG). Datum Relationships for the page SB802 as of August 1951:
0.0' NAD83 = 0.6' MLLW = 1.5' MLG

Distances on the Atchafalaya River are shown at 1 mile intervals.
