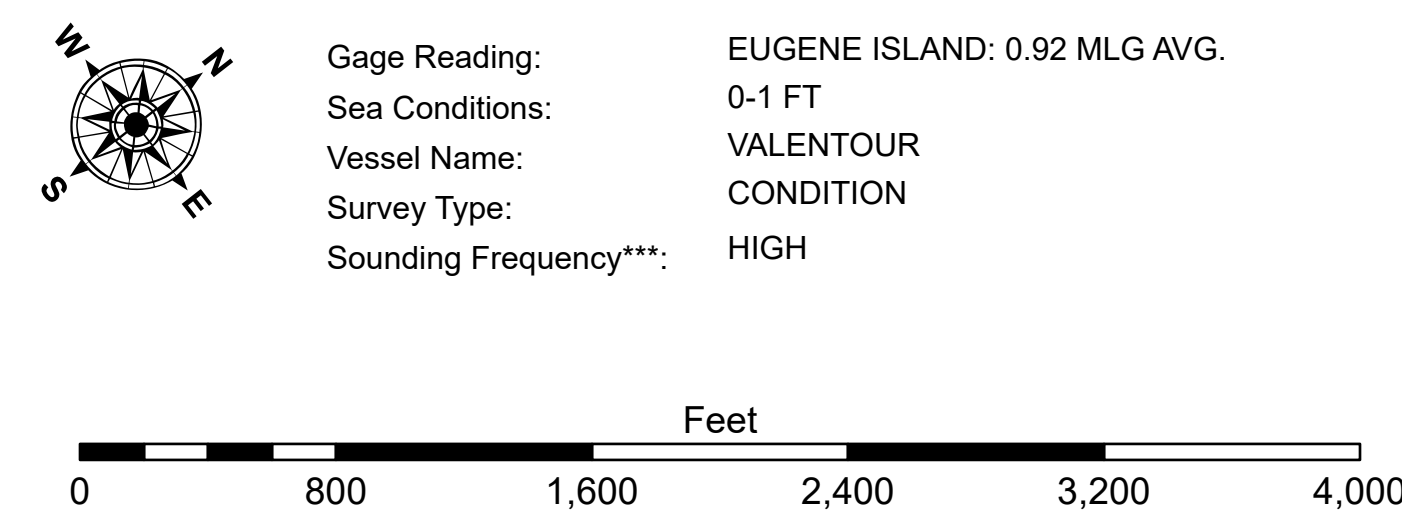
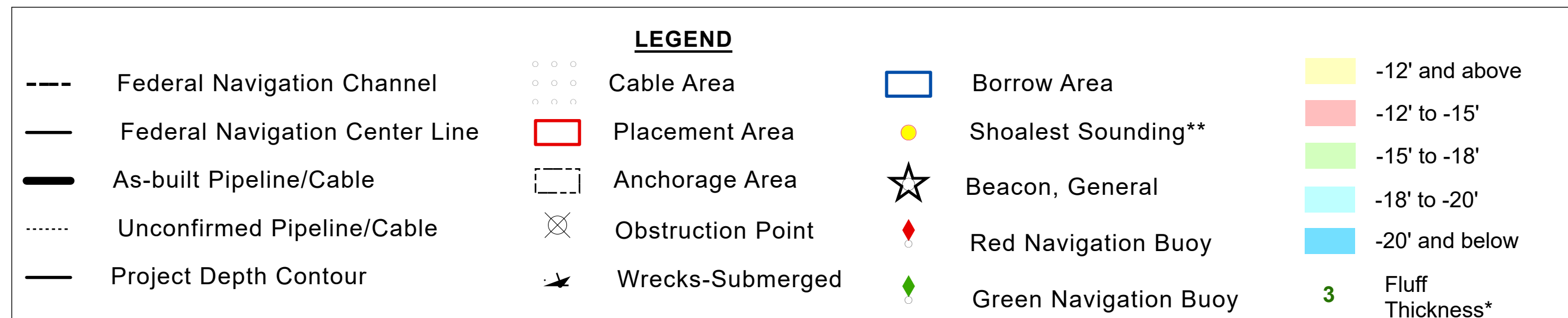
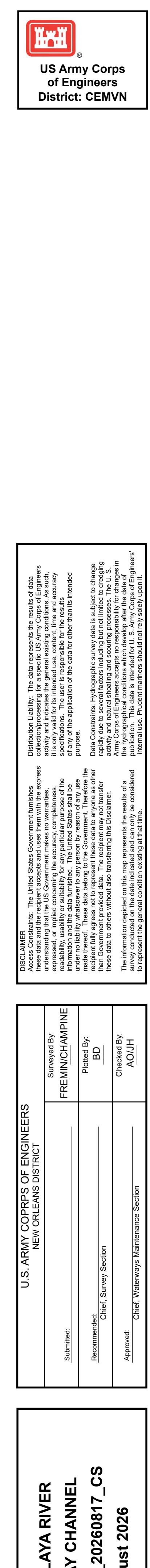

High frequency (20 kHz) survey data normally penetrates through this "fluff" layer to detect conditions of consolidated bottom material. Low frequency accuracies may vary depending on channel conditions and bottom/sediment settings.
