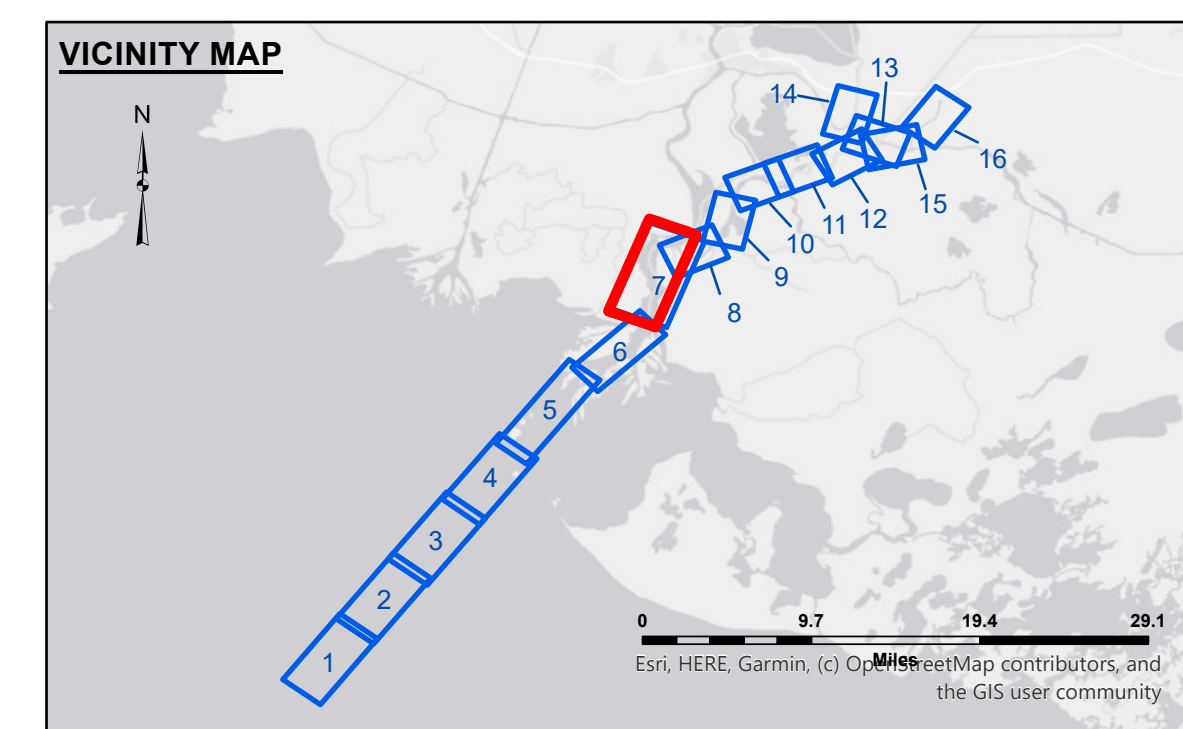
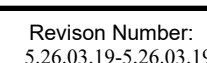
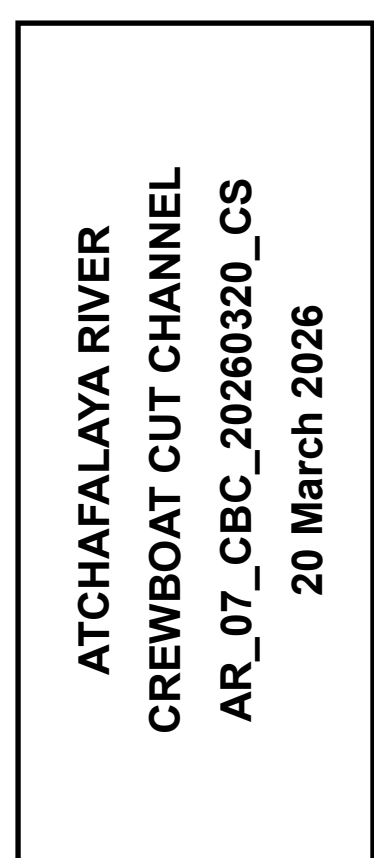
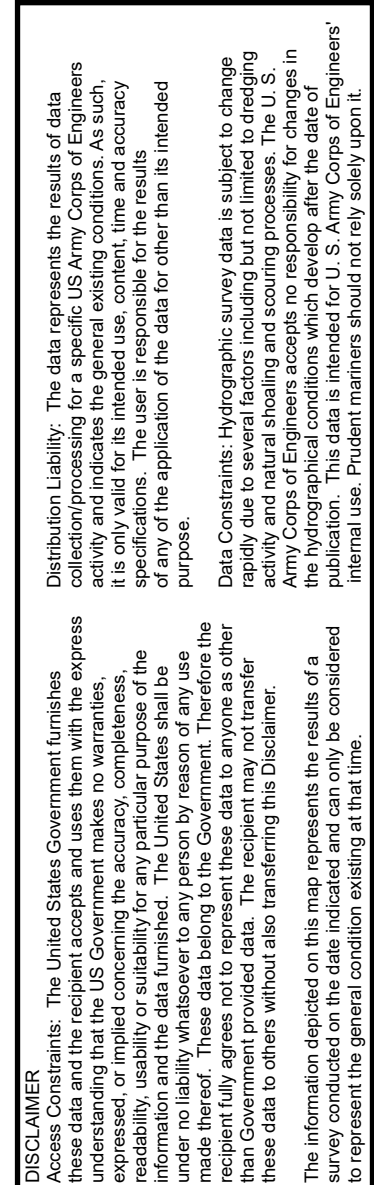




Compass rose showing North (N), South (S), East (E), and West (W) directions.

*** High frequency (200 KHz) survey data represents the first signal return at a sounding location and may include suspended solids, known as "fluff", present. Low frequency (20 KHz) survey data normally penetrates through this "fluff" layer to depict elements of consolidated bottom material. Low frequency accuracies may thus vary depending on channel conditions and bathymetric settings.
