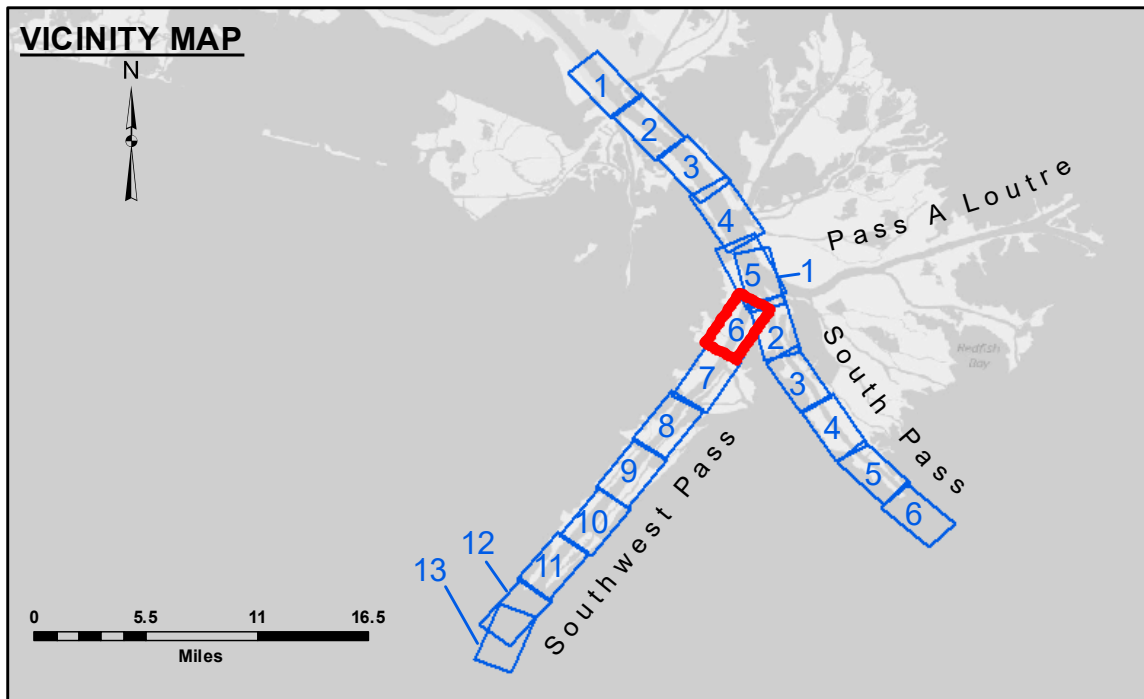


**CUTTERHEAD DREDGE R.S. WEEKS

Low frequency accuracies may vary depending on channel conditions and fathometer settings.
